

## **RULES AND REGULATIONS**

- This event is open to Malaysian citizens only. Foreigners residing in Malaysia for more than one (1) year may participate in the Squash Men's or Women's Division 1, Squash Masters & Squash57 events.
- All entries must be submitted using the official entry form. Any other method (SMS/Whatapps.etc) of submission will not be accepted.
- A knockout format for all draws except the Open Division and 8 Player draws, which will be on a circuit format.
- All players are assured of at least 2 matches
- All matches will be played according to the WSF Rules of Single Squash & WSF Rules of Single Squash57 except that one service rule will apply.
- Each entrant may nominate his/her choice of Division/Age category. However the Organizing Committee reserves the right to move a player to another Division/Age Category, without reference to the entrant and the decision shall be final.
- There shall be 5 categories of event as follow:
  - Men's and Women's Open
  - Men's and Women's Div 1
  - Men's and Women's Masters
  - Men' and Women's Squash57 Open
  - Men's and Women's Squash57 Masters
- Players are entitled to play a maximum of 3 events (Squash & Squash57) and a maximum of 2 events in either Squash or Squash57.
- All matches will be played from 4.00pm onwards. Draws and schedule will be displayed at the championships venue and the SRAM website prior to the event. There will be no rescheduling of match timings unless the Championship Director permits (In the case of extenuating circumstances).
- It is the responsibility of all participants to check their time of play.
- Events shall start as follows:
  - Divisions with 32 Player Draw: 4<sup>th</sup> July
  - Divisions with 16 Player Draw: 5<sup>th</sup> July
  - Divisions with 8 Player Draw: 6<sup>th</sup> July
- Squash57 Events shall start as follows:
  - Open Category: 5<sup>th</sup> July
  - Masters: 4<sup>th</sup> July
- Participants should report to the Championship Director at least 15 minutes prior to the advertised time of play.
- It is the players responsibility to regularly check their respective draws and schedules (in case there are changes)
- All participants are expected to mark/referee matches when requested by the Tournament Referee. Failure to do so will mean immediate disqualification from the event and withdrawal of any benefit.
- All entrants who concede walkovers in the first round, without an acceptable reason, shall be barred from participating in the Nationals next year.

- Any reason for delays or disputes shall be referred to the Championship Director or his nominated representative only, whose decisions on all matters shall be final.
- The Organizing Committee reserve the right to reject any entry without giving a reason
- All matches shall be played at the National Squash Centre, Bukit Jalil Kuala Lumpur
- If there are insufficient entries for a Division or Age Category, the Organizing Committee may decide to merge the Divisions or Age Category or cancel a Division or Age Category if the particular division does not have a minimum of 8 players.
- All juniors (Players Under 19) MUST wear protective eyewear for both Squash & Squash57 events.
- The Age cut off dates for the Masters is the FIRST day of the tournament.
- All matches will be played to, a best of 5 games and played on a 19 inch tin except for the Men's and Women's Open Division, which will be played on a 17 inch tin.
- For Squash57 events the black ball will be used for the Open, Over 35 & Over 40 events, while the blue ball will be used for the Over 50 & 60 events.
